Dogs on Club Premises Guidance

Weybridge Sailing & Recreational Boating Club acknowledges that for some members having a dog is an integral part of their enjoyment of an active outdoor lifestyle and would like to support this, whilst also respecting that not all members will be comfortable having dogs in the Club setting.

Dogs will therefore be allowed on Club premises in accordance with the following:

- Dogs must be kept within sight of their owner at all times and under the control of their owner. At no time must dogs be left unattended.
- Dogs must immediately be put on a lead without question if asked to do so by any other member of the Club, a Guest or Visitor.
- Dogs must not be left unattended while rigging or manoeuvring boats, or during any on-water boating activities; nor any other activity that means they would not be able to immediately attend to their dog. The owner must be free at all times to control their dog and restrain if necessary.
- Members will be responsible for clearing any fouling left by their dog and any residue should be hosed or rinsed with fresh water.
- Members are responsible for the conduct of their dogs at all times and must ensure that they do not display aggressive or anti-social behaviour, foul on main walkways or cause damage or fouling to other members' property. The Committee may withdraw the right of any member to bring a dog onto Club premises if, in the opinion of the committee, they are not adhering to these rules.
